

GOAL PROJECT 'WORLD TOOLS'

'WORLD TOOLS' wants to help you in preparing to return to your country. 'WORLD TOOLS' wants to help you create and develop a plan, for example to start a private "company".

A good preparation here in the Netherlands gives you better chances to make a new start in your own country.



HOW DOES THE PROJECT FUNCTION ?

Together we make a plan. In this "business-plan" we describe what you will do after returning home. We decide what activities are needed (training, courses, contact with other organisations etc.). Furthermore we look which "TOOLS" (materials, tools, machines) you need to start your business or activity. Foundation World-Wide goes in search of these tools. This 2nd hand tools, machinery, equipment and / or materials will be refurbished and / or revised by you and the volunteers of our organisation. World-Wide will provide you with a box of approximately one cubic meter in which the refurbished tools, machines and materials will be packed. When you leave, World-Wide will take care of sending the box to your country. If you need to have

additional technical training, it is possible to follow the next courses:

- carpentry
- base metal
- electric welding
- CO₂ welding
- construction
- sewing
- computer course (software and hardware)
- elektrotechnique
- entrepreneur skills ("how to start a business")
- English language

We take as much as possible your working experience into account during the chosen courses.

DURATION

Depending on your plan of return, we will consider how much time it will take to achieve this. This period will never take longer than 9 months. The sooner you start the longer and better we can help you.

If you participate, you will be maximum 4 days a week active with training and preparing your own businessplan.

FOUNDATION WORLD-WIDE

Foundation World-Wide (Stichting EereldWijd) is a school for refugees and asylum seekers. Classes are taught by motivated volunteers, supported by a small professional staff.

Students can learn a technical profession, supplemented by Dutch language course to follow technical classes more easily and for a faster integration in the Netherlands. In case of a negative decision the possibility of English language classes exists.

EXAMPLES OF INDIVIDUAL RETURNPROJECTS



Maria fled her country Angola some years ago and asked for asylum in the Netherlands. She lived in Heerlen and followed at Foundation World-Wide a computer course. She earned several degrees. The Ministry of Justice decided negative on her asylum request and Maria had to leave the country.

Maria asked Foundation World-Wide to help her building a new future, by making and realising a plan in which she can give computerlessons in Angola.

World-Wide provide Maria with a box and, together with some personal stuff, it was filled with computers and printers. Maria hopes she can make a new start.

Joe from Liberia also took this step. He was tired of the endless waiting in the Netherlands and decided to return to his own country. He has followed two welding courses at foundation World-Wide. He made a list of materials (from welding machines to sewing machines for his wife) which he wants to take to Liberia. In his country he plans to start his own welding business.



Antonio also must return to his home country. In the Netherlands he often accompanied his friend on his nights working as disc jockey at parties. Antonio sees possibilities in Angola to build a future as a disk-jockey. Antonio and foundation World-Wide are busy to look for a professional sound system. He is also building up a CD-collection, which each radio station in his home country will be envious. His box is almost full and he confidently awaits the day when he can return. He has new good hopes for his future.
